Meet Chile: Safe Haven's Clinical Director



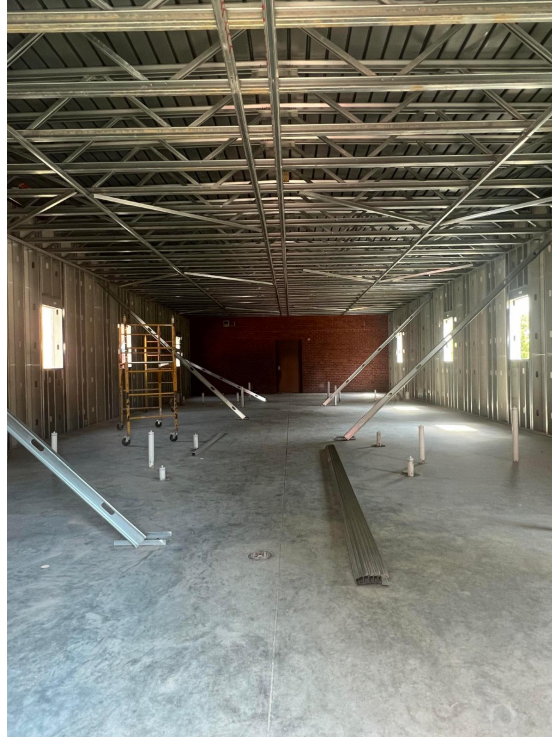
