Congratulations to Benilde Hall program graduate, Aaron! We are thrilled to welcome you to your new apartment and celebrate one full year of sobriety! Aaron stopped by our facility to share the joy of his moving day with Benilde Hall Staff and show the keys to his new apartment. A U.S. Air Force Veteran, Aaron utilized time and resources at Benilde Hall to secure permanent housing and recover from substance use disorder.



Aaron came to Benilde Hall in September of 2023, where he spent one year developing close connections with staff and clients, working towards sobriety, and finding permanent housing.

About half of Benilde Hall's beds are reserved for U.S. miliary Veterans, like Aaron. Veterans often experience invisible wounds of war that are not adequately supported during the transition to civilian life, including traumatic brain injury, PTSD, and depression. These unique challenges, in addition to the lack of supportive resources, cause Veterans to be **50% more likely to become homeless** than other Americans.

But there is hope for change. Benilde Hall clients, like Aaron, prove that with proper resources and support, we can end homelessness among Veterans in Missouri.

Overcoming homelessness and substance use disorder are challenges that require dedication and perserverence. Benilde Hall's programs help clients triumph over their individual barriers by providing a temporary housing solution, case management services, strong support networks, and access to a variety of additional resources.
